

In the Name of God Amen, I Joseph Grace of New Springfield
in the County of Hampshire & Commonwealth of Massachusetts being of
lawfull age and in bodily health and sound mind and memory
do make and ordain this my last will & Testament in the
following manner, that is to say,

First, I give and recommend my soul to God, and my body to receive
a decent Christian burial at the discretion of my Executors hereafter
named; and touching such worldly estate which I may be
seized, I dispose thereof in the following manner

Secondly, I give to my son Joseph Grace Junr. Ten Acres of Land bounded
on Rufus Leonards land West, on William Leonards land North,
on Horace Flowers land South, and to extend so far East as
to make the Ten Acres, to him the S. Joseph Grace Junr. his
Heirs & Assigns forever -

Thirdly, I give & bequeath to my Daughter Betsey Fanning, wife of
Elisha Fanning Ten Acres of Land in the same range, bounded
Westerly on the before mentioned ten Acres which I bequeath to
Joseph Grace Junr., on Daniel Leonards land North, on Horace
Flowers South, & to extend so far Easterly as to make the Ten
Acres; and also I give & bequeath to her the S. Betsey Fanning
One Cow - To her the S. Betsey Fanning her heirs & Assigns forever.

Fourthly, I give & bequeath to my daughter Mary Sargeant wife of
Samuel Sargeant Ten Acres of Land in the same range; bounded
Westerly on the before mentioned lot bequeathed to Betsey Fanning
North on Daniel Leonards land, South on Horace Flowers, &
to extend Easterly so far as to make the said Ten Acres; and
also I bequeath to the S. Mary Sargeant one Cow -
To her the said Mary Sargeant her heirs & Assigns forever -

Fifthly I give and bequeath to my Sons George Grace & William Grace, all
the rest, both of Real & personal estate which I have not herein otherwise
disposed of in this will, and of which I shall be seized, to them, their
heirs & assigns forever, to hold the same in common & undivided,
and it is my will that decent Tomb stones shall be procured and set up with
for myself & my wife Mary Grace, which together with my & her funeral ex-
penses shall be paid solely by my Sons George Grace & William Grace -
