My dear Mr. Stalker:

In response to your letter of the fifth instant, with enclosure from Mr. Frank W. Severne of Watkins, New York; I have the honor to advise you that from the papers in the Revolutionary War pension claim, R. 4171, it appears that Joseph Grace was born April 6, 1758 in Newburyport, Massachusetts or Wilmington, Middlesex County, Massachusetts.

Soldier, while living in Chelsea, Middlesex County, Massachusetts, married April 20, 1780 at said Chelsea, Mara Sargeant, who was born October 9, 1762. He died September 7, 1823 in Springfield, Massachusetts.

His widow, Mara, while a resident of Springfield Township, Bradford County, Pennsylvania, applied for pension December 4, 1838, and stated that soldier, while a resident of Reading or Wilmington,
