You will notice on the 6 page it is written in 3 places with a long s in the Joseph - you will notice in the July 1804 on 7 page, the J is made like the fac simile - I inclose an old will, sub to me as his, with his name signed larger than on the old book - On the 2^d page the J is made much like the curried copy, so with the J on the 3^d page, as well as the whole name I sub with them as they are for your better judgement
