

Personally appeared Manuel Grace who being duly sworn on his oath says that he is brother to the said Joseph Grace now deceased - that the said Joseph was in fort M^o 2 previous to the battle at Bunker Hill - said fort being near Boston & this deponent was with him in the battle at Bunker Hill in Col Parsons's regiment - after the British evacuated Boston this deponent went to the state of New York & to Long Island & said his brother Joseph remained in the vicinity of Boston & he has no knowledge of his residence just then but he believes his time of residence commenced in 1775 & that he resided three years as he understood from him & it was ever understood in this family that he resided that length of time - he was not in the vicinity of his residence at the time of his death but understood it took place about fifteen years ago - this deponent being 84 years of age

Personally appeared Mary Remington aged 64 years who being duly sworn on her oath says that she was acquainted with Joseph Grace now deceased & with Mara Sargent now Mara Grace and does present at the marriage of the said Joseph & Mara - they were married at the town of Chelms in the county of Middlebury in the state of New Hampshire so near as she can recollect in the month of April in the year 1780 & the marriage was performed by the Mr. Payson - she understood at that time that the said Joseph Grace had been in the service of the
