I hereby Certify, That, from an examination of the Books and Documents relating to Military Services in the War of the Revolution, which remain in this Department, it appears that the name of Joseph Grace, is borne upon a list of Men in Capt. Ford's Company, as a private from November 4 to January 6 - years Not given - Upon a List of Men who engaged to serve for the term of 3 Months, as a reinforcement to the Continental Army - said list is dated, "Wilmington November 29 1776" and signed, "C. Ford Capt.;" - Upon a Pay Roll of the "late" Capt Sumner's Ward's Company, in Col Coggswell's Regt as a private from October 3 to December 31 1778, 20 Miles travel included - 3 Months Name Not found upon Rolls of the 1775 Service or last 3 years Service. - There is evidence of
