 and served as a Grenadier until - honorably discharged -
 He was married in the year 1780 He died in the year 1785

The only other facts which I recollect, are as follows. Viz -
 That he resided with a Mr Butterfield, Middlesex Co. Mass. probably town
 Melrose. After his said Mother, Mr Butterfield & went to Boston, where he
