The additional testimony in the case of Mrs Maria Grace widow of Joseph Grace did not have been deposited with her other papers. The proof of the period of the marriage is sufficient but that of the service is not. Information and proof of the service relative to the company and regt in which her husband served may probably be obtained from the Town where he resided when he entered the service. The enlistment in 1775 was for eight months only. If he performed service after that year it was under other engagements,
