 an associate judge of the court of common pleas of said county  
 personally appeared the said Maria Grace & being duly sworn  
 on her oath says that a leaf herewith to be transmitted & marked  
 "A" has been cut from a family bible in her possession and contains  
 as she believes a true record of her marriage with her late  
 husband Joseph Grace which took place on the 23<sup>d</sup> of April  
 1780 - she further on her oath says that she can recollect  
 nothing as to the service of the said Joseph in the war of 1780  
 recollecting further than is stated in her original application  
 except that she understood he belonged to a company of  
 grenadiers during some part of his service & that he was  
 in the battle of Red Bank hill - she has some recollection  
 of seeing Capt Wood's name mentioned as connected with his  
 service but is not certain that he is the captain under  
 whom he served although she thinks probable that very  
 the person from the fact that she recollects such a name  
 - the leaf aforesaid & herewith to be transmitted was part  
 of an ancient family bible which has been in the family  
 of the said Joseph & since his decease has been in the  
 charge of this deponent for a long period of time and  
 she believes all the records therein contained are  
 correct.
